Characteristics

Genus & Species:Abelia x grandifloraProtection Status:US Plant Patent 16,988.USDA Zone:Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).

Bloom: Light pink buds opening to pure white tubular flowers, which persist into fall.

Bloom Time: Summer-fall. (Long Blooming Season)

Foliage: Variegated foliage. Bright yellow & green in spring, gradually changing to golden yellow & green in

the summer. Fall foliage is a combination of golden yellow bright oranges and fiery reds.

Habit: Compact tight rounded habit. 2' x 3'.

Propagation: Softwood cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun.

Additional Comments: Heat & drought tolerant once established. High fertility increase foliage retention in the winter.

Sport of A. 'Little Richard'.

Uses: Pots & containers, garden border, modern mass landscape plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

1 Gallon: 6-12 months 3 Gallon: 12-18 months

Comparison: A. 'Little Richard'
